**December 12, 2011 – February 3, 2012**

**Upload art work to:** <https://asas.kennesaw.edu/students/register>

- Each secondary art teacher can submit 20 individual student works. Each student can submit 2 art works. Teacher can either upload the art work or assist their students in uploading art work and the number of images with access code or password
- Verification email sent to teacher enabling view of JPEG images verification (edits would be possible)
- Limited time frame for upload

February 6, 2012

Art teachers check artwork and submit work by February 6 to Regional Coordinator for regional judging (**Regional coordinators are established by GAEA District size. The larger districts have more than one regional coordinator**).

- Regional coordinators judge art work and submit accepted works to KSU for state judging by February 20, 2012
- Each regional coordinator can submit 50 works for state judging.
- **Kathy and Hope: Shane and I will need the updated regional coordinator list by the first of October**

February 20, 2012

- Regional judging completed and sent to KSU for state judging
- Verification to regional coordinator listing works received at KSU by February 24, 2012

March 9, 2012

- Judging of regional works completed by state judges from online submissions
- Website link established for all regional winners for reference

March 12-16, 2012

- Email sent to art teachers with notification of works accepted for the ASAS Exhibition

**April 20, 2012**

- Art work delivered to or mailed to KSU by Friday, April 20 at 5 pm
- Award winners will be selected from final accepted works
- Notification of ASAS award winners will be sent to art teachers first of May

May 5 – 30, 2012

- Art work displayed in Kennesaw State University Fine Arts Gallery and Visual Arts building
- **ASAS exhibition closes on May 30, 2012 – art work will be shipped back if return mailing is provided or work can be picked up on May 31, after 12 noon**

- Lunch 11:30 – 12:30 (\$10)
- Awards Ceremony 1 pm (Free and open to the public)

May 31, 2011

- Art work picked up from 12 – 5 pm or by arrangement
